Western Maine Transportation Services provides public paratransit bus service on the following days from the listed towns and from towns along the route. All WMTS paratransit buses are equipped with wheelchair lifts. Rides on public paratransit buses must be scheduled as far in advance as possible by calling **800-393-9335, selection 1**.

- **Norway/South Paris** (Tuesdays)
- **Farmington/Wilton/Rumford/Mexico/Dixfield/Canton/Livermore (Brettun's) & Turner** (Wednesdays)
- **Farmington/Wilton/Jay/Livermore Falls/Livermore (Brettun's) & Turner** (Wednesdays and Fridays)
Service from as far away as Rangeley and Kingfield will be possible with sufficient notice.
